

Greater Toronto Hockey League

Player Registration Manual 2025 – 2026 As of April 24, 2025

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- The PRF fee can be paid in a one-time payment or in 5 installments.
- There is a \$40 administrative fee when selecting the installment plan.
- There is a 2% credit card processing fee added to each credit card transaction, for both payments in full and installment payments.
- U10-U18 (A, AA & AAA) Collection of payment is through the Hockey Canada online payment portal as either a
 one-time payment or six installments.
 - ▶ Installment plan 1st payment upon registration (April/ May), 2nd June 20th, 3rd July 20th, 4th August 20th, 5th on September 20th.
- Payment methods accepted are Visa, MasterCard, and cheque.
- The League will accept post-dated cheques provided they are delivered to the League Office prior to the due date
 and dated for the above noted installment dates.
- Should payment not be received as per the due dates, a financial hold will be placed on the player. All players must have the Player Registration Fee paid in full to begin programming by September 20, 2025.

U10 - U18 - 33 Games

- Cheque = \$950.00
- + 2% credit card processing fee = \$970.00
- Installment plan is subject to fees noted above plus \$40.00

AA/A

U10 - U18 - 34 Games

- Cheque = \$950.00
- +2% credit card processing fee = \$970.00
- Installment plan is subject to fees noted above plus \$40.00



Each APPROVED Team Official who is a parent or legal guardian on the same approved roster for A, AA and AAA associations, is eligible for a \$100 rebate towards the Player Registration Fee.

Application process to be announced.

NOT ELIGIBLE:

- One parent or legal guardian is a head coach, assistant coach, trainer or manager on a different approved roster than his/ her child, the player is NOT eligible to receive the \$100 rebate.
- The head coach, assistant coach, trainer or manager is a parent or legal guardian to a child other than yours, the player is NOT eligible to receive the \$100 rebate.
- The head coach, assistant coach, trainer or manager is the parent or legal guardian to two children and is part of the bench staff on two rosters, is NOT eligible two \$100 rebates.
- No sibling rebates for multi-player families.

ELIGIBLE

- One parent or legal guardian is an approved head coach, assistant coach, trainer or manager on the same approved roster as his/ her child. The player registered is eligible to receive \$100 off the Player Registration Fee.
- The second parent or second legal guardian is an approved head coach, assistant coach, trainer or manager on the same approved roster as his/ her second child. The second player registered is eligible to receive \$100 off the Player Registration Fee.



Section 2



- All players require a completed PRF Registration with full payment submitted by September 20, 2025 as a condition of approval.
- A Player who has not paid the PRF 5 days after an outstanding payment notification has been issued regarding an installment payment, will become ineligible to participate.
- A Player who suffers a season-starting or season-ending injury/ illness/ condition/ mental-health barrier would be refunded on a pro-rated basis after the submission of a medical report indicating such, and a full review by the GTHL office. Refunds are at the discretion of the GTHL.
- A Player who suffers a short-term injury (they would be returning to play at some point during the season) is not eligible for a refund.
- A Player who is suspended is not eligible for any refund.
- A Player who is released from a team and does not re-sign with a GTHL Club prior to January 15, 2026 will be eligible for a pro-rated refund which will be issued after January 15, 2026.



- A Player who registers after the start of the regular season will have the Player Registration Fee reviewed for a pro-rated refund of games missed in the regular season.
- A Team Official rebate is only to be offered to a player whose parent or legal guardian is a Team Official on their roster and is registered and not released prior to/including December 15.
- A parent or legal guardian Team Official who is released prior to or on December 15 voids that player's eligibility for the rebate.
- No more than one rebate can be applied per player.
- NSF returned cheque fee is \$25.00
- If during the installment period the players' profile becomes delinquent at any point, all rebates could become void.



- All refund requests will be processed beginning January 1, 2026. Exceptions to the January 1, 2026 date may be made on payments submitted in error or as duplicates.
- A request for a refund will only be considered if such request is submitted to the GTHL Office on or before April 15 of current playing season (e.g. for the 2025-26 season, the deadline is April 15, 2026).
- No refund requests for past seasons will be considered.


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









Select existing participant to continue. If you haven't registered your participant, select register a participant.






Choose to search your player by their HCR # or first and last name and date of birth and click search.






Once your player's name is found, a box will pop up with the confirmed information, click select. If your player doesn't show up, please make sure all information is correct.













Once you choose your package, you will click the circle and click next.










Completing the questionnaire will be required to move forward. Please select all options that pertain to you. Click next.






To pay online through credit card, select Credit Card. To pay through post dated Cheques, please select Cheque. Click Next. Cheques must be received immediately at the GTHL Office.

Section 4

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)



1) How do I know if a player is eligible to participate in a game?

A: The player will appear with an APPROVED status on the roster. This can be discussed with the club your player is registered with.

2) When a player registers late (for example, in December) is the player allowed to play immediately and/or is there a grace period to clear the payment process?

A: The player will remain ineligible on the roster until the family completes the Player Registration Fee. Once completed, the club where you are registered can submit the roster for review of the newly added player. Once payment is confirmed the player will appear APPROVED on the roster.

3) Will the Hockey Canada online registration system accept both Credit and Debit cards?

A: Hockey Canada Registry will accept Visa, and MasterCard. The League Office will accept post dated Cheques. Debit cards are not accepted.



4) Can I pay by cheque and how?

A: The Hockey Canada online registration will allow you to "check-out" by cheque. The cheque(s) must be forwarded along with the order receipt to the GTHL office. Cheques should be made out to the Greater Toronto Hockey League and include the correct deposit dates along with the players' name and HCR number in memo section.

Please forward all cheques immediately following registration.

Outstanding payments may result in the player being placed on a financial hold.

5) How is a player informed that playing privileges have been removed? Is the Club and Team informed as well?

A: The League office will notify the club President and/ or the General Manager. The club executive will be responsible for notifying the Head Coach of the team, and the family. Failure to do so will result in an ineligible player on the game sheet.

6) What happens if a team plays an ineligible player?

A: – If a player participates while ineligible, League Rules governing participation of an ineligible player will be imposed. This provision is covered in GTHL Regulation 14.4 http://www.gthlcanada.com/page/rulebook#suspensions

7) Will families who are entitled to the bench staff rebate have to pay the full Player Registration Fee upfront?

A: Yes, the full PRF is due at the time of registration. Rebates to follow later in the season.



8) How are injuries defined for the purpose of determining if a player is entitled to a refund when injured?

A: A note from a Medical Doctor would be required. ONLY season-ending injuries or season-starting injuries will be eligible and considered for refund, after a review by the league office.

9) If a payment date is missed, what are the consequences?

A: A player has 5 days after notification of an unsuccessful installment transaction to make a payment for the amount owing. After 5 days, the full payment of the fee will be due and the player will be ineligible to participate until such time as payment is made. Furthermore, if the payment is not made within the 5 days, any discounts that were applied may become void.

10) Can a player receive more than one discount?

A: No, each player is only entitled to one bench staff rebate if they have a parent or legal guardian on their roster in an APPROVED status as a Head Coach, Assistant Coach or Trainer.



11) What happens if one parent or legal guardian coach is with one sibling's team and the other parent or legal guardian is with the other sibling's team?

A: Each player on each separate roster will receive the \$100 rebate for having an APPROVED parent or legal guardian on the same roster as the child.

12) What happens if I select the wrong PRF package from my options?

A: Please email Danielle Murray, Manager, Registration at dmurray@gthlcanada.com to have the situation reviewed.

13) What happens if the GTHL season is cancelled due to Public Health direction due to pandemic conditions related to Covid-19? Is there a refund?

A: In the event as the result of a decision made by the local public health agency or a decision by the Federal, Provincial and/or Municipal government, each player affected by such decision will be refunded a portion of the Players Registration Fee on a pro-rated bases.

14) I can't register because it says my player is registered to another organization outside the GTHL.

A: The player may require a transfer from their primary organization. Please speak to the hockey club you are looking to register with.
